## Things that have been happening around town

**Grants –** We are excited to share that Burlington was selected to receive a \$600,000 grant for the design of our Waste Water Treatment Center.

**Water billing –** You should have received your water bill which is now due MONTHLY. This changed was made in order to upgrade and make things more efficient. Please contact Natalie Meisner our Deputy Clerk at the Village who will help assist with any questions. You can pay your water bill online as well.

**Moving? Water Stamp is Needed** - If you are moving out of town you will now be required to have a water stamp at your closing from the Village of Burlington. There is no charge for the stamp. We ask that you contact the Village at least 48 hours before closing on the sale of your home.

**Public Works Department –** Thank you to our public works department for getting us through winter. They are now focused on pot hole repairs, street repairs, and all of the work that comes with the warmer weather.

**Water conservation –** Ordinance takes effect again on May 1, 2024. Odd and even watering of lawns with time limits of 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. to midnight. Signs are posted around town.

**Garage Sales –** Three per year, not to exceed nine days total per year. Please call the Village to register.

**ATV'S - Non-Highway vehicles** – are permitted on the streets under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Village of Burlington subject to the following requirements: Equipment: Brakes, a steering apparatus, tires, rearview mirror, approved "slow moving vehicle" emblem on the rear of the vehicle, headlights that emit white light visible from a distance of at least 500 fee and tail lamps that emit red light visible from a distance of at least 500 fee and tail lamps that emit red light visible from a distance of seats available on the particular vehicle. If the vehicle is not equipped with a turn signal, the operator of the vehicle will use current accepted hand signals to sign turning. They must also comply with all traffic laws, no driving on sidewalks, Village Streets only and may be operated during daytime and nighttime hours.

\*\* Dirt bikes have been seen in the Park detention area (near Burlington Road) causing ruts and major damage. <u>Please refrain from riding where it is not allowed</u>!!
